NOTICE TO THE CANDIDATES FOR MOP-UP ROUND COUNSELLING FOR ADMISSION INTO BDS COURSE UNDER COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA FOR THE YEAR 2022-23

1. The counseling will be conducted for the following vacancies (except sports & games) quota which are available due to non-joining of allotted candidates in Phase – II.

- <u>Note:</u> The seats reserved for Sports & Games quota will be filled as and when the final priority list is received from the Sports Authority of Andhra Pradesh.
- 2. The candidates who were allotted seats in Phase-I to Phase II counseling (both reported and not reported candidates) are not eligible for this Mop-up round.
- 3. As per the orders dated.22.07.2022 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Contempt Petition (C) No.289 of 2022 and as per the Notice No.U-12021/01/2022- MEC, dt.12-07-2022 of DGHS, HM&FW Govt. of India, New Delhi, the joined candidates up to round 2 of AIQ or State Quota shall not be eligible to participate in the further rounds for All India Quota or for State Quota from the academic year 2022-23 onwards.
- 4. The seats under Competent Authority Quota available for mop-up round counselling is placed in the University website.
- The candidates who are in the Provisional Final Merit list and subsequent Addendum & Corrigendum, if any, under Competent Authority Quota and NOT ALLOTTED BDS SEAT IN EARLIER PHASES OF COUNSELING ARE ONLY ELIGIBLE.
- 6. The candidates are instructed to visit the website:<u>https://ugcq.ntruhsadmissions.com/</u> for status of allotment and downloading the order.
- 7. Candidate can download the provisional allotment order on payment of University Fee Rs.10,600/through payment gateway. The students can login and view the college wise list of selected candidates in the website.
- 8. Candidates are informed to check their final allotment on website and take the printout of allotment letter from the portal and report to the respective colleges on or before the date specified on the Provisional allotment letter.
- 9. Candidates shall pay the tuition fee to complete the admission process, failing which the candidate will lose the admission.
- 10. Candidates who are allotted seat in the mop-up round counseling have to report to the allotted college with all original certificates, provisional allotment order and provisional verification copy and pay the tuition fee and college fee.
- 11. The original certificates will be verified at the college and in case of any discrepancy the provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated as per University regulations.
- 12. The University fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
- 13. No candidate is permitted to withdraw from the course till closure of the admissions.
- 14. As per G.O.Ms.No.72, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dt.15-07-2019, if any candidate wants to withdraw from the course after the closure of admissions, in the middle of the course such candidate has to submit his/her request through the Principal of the college concerned along with course discontinuation fee of Rs.1,00,000/- for BDS plus GST as applicable to the University by way of demand draft drawn in favour of the Registrar, Dr. YSR University of Health Sciences, payable at Vijayawada.

Note: The requests received directly from the candidates for withdrawal from BDS course will not be entertained under any circumstances. Any request shall be routed through Principal concerned only as per the G.O.Ms.No.72, HM & FW (C1) Dept, dated.15-07-2019.
