UNIVERSITY FEE: Candidates to whom seat is allotted have to pay Rs.23,600/for downloading allotment letter. The payment is to be paid through payment Gateway <u>https://mdscq.ysruhs.com/</u> by using Online payment method. (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking). Candidates already paid in Phase-I need not to pay again.

	2. After completion of the final Counseling for service seats, the unfilled service seats shall be identified for its original category in the seat matrix of the service seats and shall be added to the non-service seats before commencement of the second counseling for non-service seats.			
2	Eligibility for Exercising web options in this Phase-II Counselling			
	The following candidates are eligible: a) Candidates who have joined/have been not allotted any seat in Phase-I counselling.			
	b) Those candidates who have been allotted a seat in Phase-I but not reported/not joined from allotted seat at the allotted colleges. However, if a candidate has not joined/reported in the allotted seat of Phase-I then that particular seat shall not be available for that candidate to exercise web options in this Phase-II counselling.			
	Note: Candidates holding a PG Dental seat in AIQ/Telangana State are not eligible to participate in this Phase-II.			
3	Candidates are advised to go through the Prospectus (placed in the University website on 21-07-2023) and the Government Orders on Rules of PG admissions available before exercising web options. Candidates are also advised to go through the details about "MRC" concept which is exemplified below:			
	Example:			
	a) In a particular college MDS(Conservative Dentistry) seat is under "Open Category" in the seat matrix and a SC candidate is allotted that Open Category MD(Conservative Dentistry) seat in Open Round Counselling of Phase-I as per his/her web options and NEET -MDS Rank merit order of the candidate. Now this candidate is shown as Meritorious Reserved Candidate (MRC).			
	b) The same SC candidate has slided to MD (Prostho) SC category seat in the same college or another college during the Category Round of Phase-I Counselling conducted on the same day , then that MD(Conservative Dentistry) seat vacated by this MRC candidate shall be filled with the SC candidates only by merit amongst them.			
	c) This type of MRC concept is to be followed for all BC/SC/ST categories in order to maintain 50 : 50 ratio of Open : Category Reservation

4	1. Candidates opting for PG(Dental) Degree/Diploma courses are informed that, there is no limit of choices (number) for exercising web options. Candidates can exercise any number of options for any number of subjects and colleges if the candidate is interested to join as per eligibility.			
	2. Candidates are advised to exercise web options for PG (Dental) seats in all courses and colleg in which they are interested to join irrespective of available seats shown in seat matrix, vacancies will arise during counseling process due to sliding of candidates from allotted seats the Phase-I counseling to other seats as per their web options in this Phase-II counseling. candidates are not interested to join in any subject or college they should not exercise w options for the same.			
	3. If a PG (Dental) seat is allotted in this Phase-II counseling as per web options exercised by the candidate, the seat allotted in Phase-I counseling will be automatically cancelled and allotted to the other candidate. Therefore the candidates are informed to exercise web options carefully.			
5	Candidates are instructed to be careful while exercising options on the Web and take the print out of the saved options. Candidates are advised to exercise options in Courses and colleges in which they are really interested. If they are not interested to join any subject or college then they should not exercise options for the same.			

6	Candidate can exercise web options from any place having internet facility One Time Password will be sent to the registered mobile number at the time of saving Web options.
	I) Selected Options can be slided either up or down, added and deleted.II) Web options opted must be saved by the candidate.III) Web options once submitted can not be Edited.IV) Web options saved but not submitted until the cut off date and time will be Auto submitted.
7	1. The selected candidates shall produce all the Original certificates, pay the Tuition fee, necessary bonds etc., and complete the process of admission. If the candidate does not fulfil the above criteria to complete the admission process in the specified dates of admission, their admission will be cancelled automatically.
	2. Candidates who were allotted a seat in Phase-I counselling in any college of AP State, joined and slided to another college in AP in this Phase-II Phase counseling, should submit the tuition fee receipt, Custodian/acknowledgement of Original certificates issued by the earlier college for admission at the newly allotted college. The first college where the candidate initially joined in Phase-I will transfer the tuition fee, Original certificates etc., to allotted college in this Phase-II.
8	The verification of original certificates will be conducted at the time of admission in the respective College and in case of any discrepancy, the Provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated.
9	The University fee and other fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
