The Notification is issued for registration of eligible candidates to appear for MDS Part I , Part II Dental Degree/ Diploma Supplementary Examinations scheduled from 30.05.2024.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

I.MDS Part-I

- 1. The candidates admitted to the Ist year MDS course in the PG Dental Colleges affiliated to Dr.YSR University of Health Sciences for the Academic Year 2022-23 and completed the study period of One year after admission and put in a minimum attendance of 80% are eligible to appear for MDS part-I Examinations in May, 2024.
- 2. The candidates admitted prior to 2022-23 who have appeared for Part-I MDS Examinations held in December, 2023 (or) prior examinations and failed in the said examinations, are eligible to appear for MDS Examinations in May, 2024. These candidates are eligible to apply failed subject (Basic Science).

II. MDS Part-II (PG Dental Degree/ Diploma).

The <u>PG Dental Degree courses</u> candidates (2020-21 batch) who have completed 3 Academic Years of study period and passed the subject(Basic Science) of MDS Part-I and minimum attendance of 80% are eligible to apply for appearing MDS Part-II Examination.

- 1. The candidates those who have appeared MDS Part-II examinations held in December, 2023 (or) prior examinations, but failed, are also eligible to appear for this supplementary examinations May, 2024.
- 2. The candidates admitted to the <u>PG Dental Diploma courses</u> in the Dental Colleges affiliated to Dr.YSR University of Health Sciences for the Academic Year 2021-22 and completed the study period of 2 years after admission and put in a minimum attendance of 80% are eligible to appear for PG Dental Diploma Examinations in May, 2024.
- 3. The candidates those who have appeared MDS Degree/Diploma Final year examinations held in December, 2023 (or) prior examinations, but failed, are also eligible to appear for this supplementary examinations May, 2024.
- 4. The candidates who will complete their course of study period by <u>31.03.2024</u>, are also eligible to apply. Hence, the Principals are directed to verify the cutoff date before entering data in the Medhas Portal of the University.
- 5. The candidates shall have to pass the part –I examination atleast 6 months prior to the final Part II exams.

- 6. The candidates should have submitted dissertations within the time schedule fixed by the University as already notified.
- 7. The study period of those candidates who availed maternity leave upto 120 days (04 months) will be extended to the extent of maternity leave availed. They will be eligible to appear for the Examination only after completion of three years study period in MDS course as per Dr.YSR UHS Regulations.
- 8. The duration of the study period of candidates is extendable incase of availment of Medical leave/Maternity Leave/Any other Leave/absence beyond 30 days in each year.
- 9. The Principal concerned should submit period completion certificate of the students.

Note: Hall Tickets to the candidates for MDS Part- II will be issued only <u>if their dissertations are approved.</u>

http://drntruhs.nic.in/medhas institution on or before 30.03.2024 for issue of E-Hall Tickets."

V. Therefore, the Principals are advised to collect and remit the Examinations fee through online payment mode at https://drysr.uhsap.in/epay/ by30.03.2024 and send the same to the University along with exam material (student details, fee, attendance statement, freezed copy etc.) and printout of data which is uploaded in Medhas Portal to reach by 04.04.2024.

The following copies of certificates shall be enclosed by the candidates along with the application.

- a) Evidence of the date of birth (SSC or its equivalent Examination Certificate) attested Xerox copy only.
- b) Two Testimonials from any two Lecturers of the college concerned.
- c) Attendance / Eligibility Certificate from the Principal
- d) The Candidates who are from outside the state should submit their Migration Certificate.

- e) Copy of BDS Original Degree (Attested Xerox copy only).
- f) Copy of Part I Marks Memo by the students those who are appearing the MDS Part II Exams.

Unless these certificates are enclosed with the application, the application will not be considered and there will not be any further correspondence with the candidate.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE PRINCIPALS:

- 1. The Principals are informed to verify the eligibility of the students before submitting the data on the Portal.
- 2. If any ineligible student details furnished on the Medhas Portal, the Principal is solely held responsible for that.

In view of Digital Valuation of PG Dental Degree/ Diploma answer scripts a single 68 pages OMR answer book with 64 writable pages will be issued to the candidates appearing for May, 2024 Examinations and no additional answer book will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the question in the single answer book of 64 writable pages only.

Principals are requested to furnish the advance amount required. If previous advance is not settled, fresh advance will not be sanctioned.

Please also furnish the list of faculty working in their institutions who are eligible as a examiners.
